Minutes of meeting held under the Chairmanship of Secretary(HFW) on 6th May, 2016 at 5.30 pm.


A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HFW) at 5.30 pm on 6th May, 2016, in his committee room, to discuss regarding structure for tie-up with existing reputed Institutes for mentoring new AIIMS. The following were present in the meeting:

- ii) Director, AIIMS, New Delhi
- iii) Director, AIIMS, Raipur
- iv) Director, AIIMS, Patna
- v) Dean, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar
- vi) JS (PMSSY)
- vii) Director (PMSSY)

2. Following decisions were taken in the above-mentioned meeting :

- A committee under chairmanship of Director, AIIMS New Delhi is formed to facilitate mentoring of new upcoming AIIMS by existing INIs like AIIMS New Delhi, PGIMER Chandigarh and JIPMER Puducherry.
- This committee will comprise of Directors of all AIIMS (new and existing), JIPMER, Puducherry and PGI, Chandigarh, along with representatives from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.
- This committee will meet on quarterly basis to oversee issues related to new AIIMS and assist/advise in developing standards and excellence in these upcoming institutes. Deans/Nodal Officers from Institutes will also attend these meetings.
- These meetings may be held in different participating institutions by rotation.
- Department wise resource pool of mentors will be created, whose services for mentoring can be availed through nodal person to be identified by above committee, department-wise/speciality-wise.
- Extensive use of IT will be done to share educational and clinical practices with new AIIMS.
- The mentoring will done in four broad areas:
 - i. **Teaching:** To have faculty sharing, common syllabus, adoption of standard teaching practices for faculty and paramedics, virtual classroom and tele education in new AIIMS through existing INIs.
 - ii. **Clinical:** Professional training through short duration visits, supervised training for clinical practices etc.

- iii. **Asset creation:** Assisting in setting up high tech labs, standardisation of designs and equipments etc.
- iv. **Research:** Multi-disciplinary multi centric research on international line will be encouraged.
- The committee will also workout options for international collaboration of these new AIIMS.
