Subject: Extension of benefits of 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) – Revision of Pay and Allowances of Non-Faculty in respect of six new AIIMS-reg.

Dear Madam/Sir,

Consequent upon the implementation of the 7th Pay Commission for Central Government employees, the proposal of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare regarding extension of benefits of 7th CPC in respect of six new AIIMS located at Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna, Raipur and Rishikesh has been considered in the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure.

2. Approval of the Government is hereby conveyed for revision of pay and allowances of Non-Faculty members in accordance with Ministry of Finance OM No. 1/1/2016-E.III (A) dated 13.01.2017 & 26.07.2017. Only normal replacement pay scales as per Part A of the Schedule of CCS (RP) Rules, 2016 may be given to Non-Faculty of the six new Institutes. The decision on such of the existing allowances at present admissible to Non Faculty of the six new AIIMS as are exactly as per Central Government pattern will also be in accordance with Department of Expenditure OM No. 1/1/2016-E-III (A) dated 26th July, 2017, effective from 1st July 2017.

3. The effective date of fixation of pay and allowances in the six Institutes are 01.01.2016 and 01.07.2017 respectively.


4. It is also pointed out that in accordance of the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure OM No29/1/2017-E.II (B) dated 11 July 2017, it is stated that as the recommendations of the 7th CPC on allowances have come into effect from 1st July 2017, disbursement of all existing allowances which have not been specifically recommended for continuation in terms of the Resolution dated 6th July 2017 shall be discontinued from the salary of the month of July, 2017.

5. Anomalies, if any, in the implementation of this order may be brought to the notice of the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, for clarification/ decision of the Central Government.

6. This issues with the approval of Integrated Finance Division of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare vide its Diary No.C-2226 dated 30.11.2017.

7. The six new AIIMS are also advised to place the proposal of extension of benefits of 7th CPC to Non-Faculty employees for adoption by their respective Institute Bodies in due course.

Subject: Extension of benefits of 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) –Pay Revision of Pay and Allowances of Faculty in respect of six new AIIMS.

Dear Madam/Sir,

Consequent upon the implementation of the 7th Pay Commission for Central Government employees, the proposal of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare regarding extension of benefits of 7th CPC in respect of six new AIIMS located at Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna, Raipur and Rishikesh has been considered in the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure.

2. In so far as revision of pay scales in case of Faculty posts is concerned, it was clarified by Ministry of Health & FW to Ministry of Finance that the existing pay scales of Faculty as specified by Ministry of Health as per their OM dated 31.12.2009 and 12.01.2010 were adopted on the basis of the pay scales allowed by the Ministry of HRD in respect of Faculty of Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIS), namely, IIM, IIT etc. as contained in their letter dated 18.08.2009.

3. Ministry of HRD, Department of Higher Education has since issued order no. 15-4/2017-TC dated 27th October, 2017, accordingly the **revised pay of Faculty of six new AIIMS** would be as under:

The decision on such of the existing allowances at present admissible to Faculty of the six new AIIMS as are exactly as per Central Government pattern will also be in accordance with Department of Expenditure OM No. 1/1/2016-E-III (A) dated 26th July, 2017, effective from 1st July 2017.
