REPLY TO THE QUERIES RAISED IN THE PRE-BID MEETING  
HELD ON 26-2-2019


The queries raised by the participants and their reply are tabulated as under:

Sl. No.	Query	Reply of MoH&FW
1.	Detailed scope of IT & Networking may be provided. Does it include HMIS also or only planning, designing of IT and telephone as mentioned at point K Page No. 7	It is clarified that all the hardware and networking items are included in the scope. However, all application software viz. HMIS and Queue Management System are excluded from the scope of work of Executing Agency.
2.	Page no 8- w.r.t. MGPS & MoT it is mentioned that "The consultancy fee for items under this para may be indicated separately. "Quote for these items are required to be quoted in percentage or in lump sum? Price sheet format may accordingly also modified.	Only one single lump sum amount is to be quoted as Consultancy fee to cover all aspects of Consultancy works.
3.	Timeline for the project may also be considered like previous AIIMS (Guwahati, Gorakhpur, Bathinda) or it may be optimized as per attached sheet.	No change in time line is possible as the same has already been approved by Union Cabinet. The word 'Global' where ever appearing may be treated as deleted / removed.
4.	Do the appointment of architecture is through global bidding? Because it is mentioned at some places but not mentioned at few other places.	It is not through global bidding. The word 'Global' appearing in the RFP may be treated as deleted / removed.
5.	Please define point L at page no 7 and Point XVI at page no 10. Any other extra work shall be mutually agreed at additional consultancy fee.	It is a turnkey project and rates should be quoted accordingly. Any consultancy work which is incidental for the main Project execution works will be included in the scope of work under the present RFP.
6.	Do we include operation and maintenance during DLP of 1 year? If yes the Consultancy fee of EA shall be applicable.	Maintenance is included for DLP i.e. one year and during this period no extra consultancy fee shall be payable.
7.	MoHFW may kindly clarify whether NBCC and HSCC are considered as two separate bidders. As we understand that the strategic sale of HSCC has been made to NBCC and they are under one management control. Separate bid by both the companies under same ministry would not have sanctity.	As clarified by NBCC, M/s HSCC is also permitted to bid, separate from NBCC.

NBCC, HSCC and HITES wanted the site plan, which has been declined as there is no such practise. These PSUs are already undertaking works of establishment of AIIMS in different States. The infrastructure and facilities to be created under the project have already been detailed in the RFP.

HSCC has also pointed out that since HLL is under sale, they should not be included in the shortlist of PSUs eligible for bidding. The contention of HSCC is not acceptable as on the date of bid, HLL continues to be a PSU.

Last date of submission of financial bids is 06.05.2019 by 3.00 PM. The bids will be opened on 06.05.2019 @ 03.30 PM.
