Minutes of Pre-bid meeting held on 20-11-2018 at 3.00 PM in Room No. 406-A-Nirman Bhawan, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi.

The following points were discussed:

- (i) Smt. Mansi Rai, Senior Executive, SGS India, Gurgaon has requested that her firm is a private firm, but having a large experience in TPQA work. The relaxation may be given to SGS India to participate in Bid process. Director, PMSSY has categorically mentioned that this bidding process is meant only for eligible CPSUs / Government institutions and permission to private firms cannot be granted at this stage.
- (ii) Shri Naresh Mahajan, Head TPQA, PEC-CCE, Chandigarh has mentioned that the Institute has completed a lot of TPQA work successfully, but they don't have completion certificate of any TPQA work done. But they have work orders / award letters. Director, PMSSY has clarified that completion certificate issued by the officer of appropriate level is an essential document required to evaluate the technical bid. Hence exemption as asked for cannot be granted. The Institute can submit the completion certificate alongwith technical bid document, if they so desire after obtaining the same from the concerned authorities where they have completed the TPQA work.
- (iii) Shri Kripakar Mishra, Senior Manager, the representative from RITES, Gurgaon has submitted their queries in writing. Each of the points raised by them was discussed in the meeting and clarifications given. The same is as under:
